The German Modern Pentathlon Federation has the pleasure to invite a delegation of your country to participate in the Int. German Championships Laser-Run & Obstacle-Laser-Run that will be held in Nuremberg from June 15th to June 16th, 2024, according to the following programme:

Participation and Entries:

participants: Laser-Run

Elite and Open Category: U9 - Masters 70+ (Single and Mixed Relays)

Fun Category: U9 - Masters 70+ (Single and Relays)

Obstacle-Laser-Run

Elite and Open Category: U15 - Masters 50+ (Single)

Fun Category: U15 - Masters 50+ (Single)

Elite Category: Athletes who are members of a sports club that belongs to a DVMF regional association, have a properly maintained DVMF sports pass with an annual license for 2024 and have a permanent residence in Germany (with the appropriate residence permit).

Open Category/Fun Category: Anyone can take part in competitions in the open category and the fun category. Athletes who are eligible to compete for a club or association from Russia or Belarus are currently excluded from participation. Each participant is responsible for their own sporting health. Minors can only take part in the elite category and in the open category with a valid health certificate (not older than 1 year).

Ranking:

For all age groups, in addition to the elite category ranking, a combined overall ranking is kept with the open category. A separate ranking is kept for all age groups in the fun category. Relay teams whose relay partners belong to different



age groups are assigned to the higher-performing age group. If masters start with athletes in the junior age group or younger, the relay team is ranked in the senior age group. If necessary, several age groups may start together in one race.

Medals & titles: German Champion

The title of German Champion is only awarded to participants in the elite category. The first three athletes in each age group receive medals; all participants will receive certificates. All participants in the IDM Laser Run also receive ranking points in accordance with the DVMF competition regulations for Laser Run. When calculating the ranking points, a competition weighting factor of 2 is used.

German Relay Mixed Champion

The title of German Relay Mixed Champion is only awarded to mixed relays in the elite category; all mixed relays will receive certificates.

Winner of the combined ranking & winner of the combined relay ranking

The awards of winner of the combined ranking and winner of the combined relay ranking are given to participants in the combined overall ranking of the elite category and open category; all individual participants and all relays will receive certificates.

Fun Champion & Fun Champion Relay

The awards of Fun Champion and Fun Champion Relay are given to participants in the fun category; all individual participants and all relays will receive certificates.

Qualification for finals:

If there are more than 18 total entries per age group in the Elite and Open competition categories, preliminary heats will be held to allocate starting places in the final runs in accordance with the requirements of the DVMF Laser Run competition regulations. The same applies to the mixed relays. In the Fun category, if there are more than 18 entries per age group, several runs will take place; the participants will be placed in the order of their finishing times.

Entry: Please make your entry via the portal www.Laser-Run.de, registration is required before. The registration confirmation will be sent by email after receipt of the registration fee (and any applicable pistol rental fee) and must be presented at check-in.

Closing of the registration: June 9th.2024.

Entry fee: **Laser-Run Elite Category and Open Category:** 30 € / athlete, 30 € /relay
Laser-Run Fun-Kategorie: 20 € /athlete, 20 € /relay.
Obstacle-Laser-Run Elite Category and Open Category: 40 € /athlete-
Obstacle Laser-Run Fun Category: 30 € / athlete

10% discount for clubs or schools with a minimum of 10 participants.

Laser pistol rental fee: 5 € / competition

Rental pistols are reserved in the order in which the registration fee and rental fee are received.



Accommodation:

Participants are responsible for their own accommodation. There is a wide range of accommodation options available in and around Nuremberg. A wide range of food and drinks is available on site.

Competition rules:

The competition will be carried out according to the DVMF Laser Run & Obstacle Rules:

Obstacle: a 70 m outdoor course with eight obstacles of the UIPM course type “Category A, B, and C Competition” with electronic timing. Obstacle No. 3 (LOC CHOICE 1) is “Over-under-through” and No. 5 (LOC CHOICE 2) is “Balance Beam” according to UIPM Obstacle Competition and Equipment Guidelines.

Running Course and Timing: Synthetic track and grass; electronically assisted manual timing.

Shooting Range: 18 + 2 competition laser shooting ranges (hit & miss laser targets with external displays and shooting tables with support mats) as well as 10 separate shooting ranges for Warm up. Laser pistols can be rented to a limited extent and for a fee.

Shooting practice is only permitted at the competition laser shooting range (during warm-up) and at the separate laser shooting range (if necessary, in separately marked areas). On Saturday, June 15, 2024, the obstacle race and laser run of the German U15 Modern Pentathlon Championships will take place on the same competition site.

By registering you agree to the privacy policy as well as the anti doping rules and regulations of UIPM and DVMF. (1) The personal data provided by the participant during registration will be stored and processed only for the purposes of carrying out and managing the event, as well as for creating and maintaining ranking lists and for providing information about other laser run competitions. This applies in particular to the data required for payment processing. By registering, the participant consents to the storage of the data for these purposes. (2) By registering, the participant agrees that his surname, first name, year of birth, club, school and regional association may be used for start and



result lists and the photos, film recordings and interviews taken in connection with his participation in the event may be distributed and published nationally and internationally, in particular on the Internet, without entitlement to remuneration. (3) In the case of collective registrations, the registrant declares that he has informed each of his registered athletes about paragraphs (1) and (2) and that they or their parents (in the case of minors) have consented. (4) Participants may withdraw their consent given in accordance with paragraphs (1) and (2) with future effect. If the withdrawal occurs before the competition, participation in the competition is not possible.
